#### **VOUCHER PROCESS**

- 1. Customer finds Participating Installer via Renewable Energy Resource Center (RERC) or Efficiency Vermont .
- 2. Participating installer applies on customer's behalf for Windham County AWHS Income-eligible Incentive Adder BEFORE project starts
- 3. RERC reviews application.
- 4. If RERC approves incentive, Customer receives approval & voucher for Windham County AWHS Income-eligible Incentive Adder.
- 5. Participating installer completes project & submits voucher, invoice, and photos of the installed systems.
- 6. Participating installer receives a reimbursement check from the State of Vermont via the Clean Energy Development Fund (CEDF).
